

Single Stream Recycling Program



Welcome to Goddard's single stream recycling program initiative. Executive Order (EO) 13514, "Federal Leadership in Environmental, Energy, and Economic Performance," requires that by the year 2015 we increase our recycling collection fifty percent over our 2008 baseline. In an effort to meet the mandates of this EO, GSFC will be implementing the Single Stream Recycling Program at both Goddard Space Flight Center (GSFC) and Wallops Flight Facility (WFF). Our goal is to exceed expectations set by the federal mandate and the President's initiative on recycling.

In Single Stream Recycling, recyclable materials are collected in one container. The unsorted or comingled materials are placed in a collection bin until processed at an offsite Material Recovery Facility specifically designed for sorting and processing of recyclables.

At Wallops you will see new containers set up in vending or other designated recycling areas of the building. **The Single Stream Recycling Program will be fully in place at both sites by September 1, 2011.**

Items Allowed in the Single Stream Recycling Program
